

## Annual Report 2023-24 on CSR Activities Implemented with the Support of GMR Pochampalli Expressways Limited (GPEL)

The CSR fund (Rs. 62.70 lakhs) of GPEL for 2023-24 has been contributed to GMR **Varalakshmi Foundation**, the CSR arm of the GMR Group.

GMRVF undertakes CSR activities at all the business locations of the Group under its thrust areas of

- **Education**
- **Health and Sanitation**
- **Empowerment and Livelihoods**
- **Community Development**

The CSR fund from GPEL has been spent for various social developments initiatives across GMR group business locations in the country.

### **Pochanpalli Expressway Region: Education activities.**

- Supported 3 Govt. schools for academic, extra-curricular activities and celebration of important days.
- Implemented Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN) Skills program in 3 Govt. Primary schools. Around 260 students benefitted from this program.
- 16 students from supported schools got selected for National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship.
- 16 students from supported schools got admissions in TS Residential and TS Sports Schools.
- Conducted summer special activity-based classes in 2 primary schools and library, 105 children benefitted
- Specialized GMRVF workbooks distributed to 500 primary school students. Distributed study material and examination kits to 850 Std. X students at Govt. Schools.



### **Hyderabad Vijayawada Expressway: Education Activities**

- Provided Vidya Volunteer support to 3 Govt. schools benefiting about 330 children.
- Supported Govt. Schools with Teaching-Learning Material, SSC Exam Materials, Workbooks, Notebooks, Chairs, Tables and provided need-based infrastructure support benefiting 2987 children.
- GMRVF distributed Steel Glasses to 350 govt school children to drink Ragi Java at ZPHS Gundrampally, MPPS Panthangi and Korlapahad Schools.

- Developed one of the Govt. Schools supported by the Foundation as a Model School by improving the FLN (Foundational Literacy Numeracy) skills of the children and by providing need-based infrastructure support.



### Chennai ORR: Education Activities

- Partnered with 10 Govt. Schools to improve the quality of education for the benefit of 3685 children.
- Repairs and Educational wall painting was undertaken at 5 Anganwadi centers and Govt. schools.
- Two Anganwadi centers were recognized as 'Model Anganwadi Centers' by ICDS department.
- TLM material was provided to 5 Illam Thedi Kalvi (tuition) centers in the target villages benefiting 175 school students.
- 150 SSLC exam kits were supported to 2 Government schools



### Pochanpalli Expressway Region: Community Development, Empowerment & Road Safety

- Conducted 130 Road Safety awareness programs for different target groups covering 28655 individuals involving important stakeholders such as Police, Road Transport Dept. etc.
- Developed tailor-made media tools such as road safety demo tent, road safety week leaflets, user specific pamphlets, banners, videos, etc. to be used for different target groups.
- Observed National Road Safety Month 2024, reached out 9400 road users.

- As per NHAI Guidelines, observed Azadi Ka Amrit Mahostav at Project location.



### Hyderabad Vijayawada Expressway: Community Development, Empowerment & Road Safety

- Conducted 129 Road Safety and Community awareness programs and reached out to over 22,582 road users.
- Conducted Road safety awareness programs at the companies along the road stretch, at Toll plazas and with Communities.
- Conducted a Road Safety Summer Camp for the students of the Govt. Schools in the project area.
- Observed National Road Safety Month and sensitized about 3930 Road users on Road Safety.
- Celebrated 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' in the project area by involving the Officials from NHAI and conducted various activities like felicitation of workers etc.



### Chennai ORR: Community Development, Empowerment & Road Safety

- Observed 32<sup>nd</sup> National Road Safety Month from January 15<sup>th</sup> January to 14<sup>th</sup> February 2024 and sensitized about 25000 road users through various awareness programs on road safety.
- Conducted 117 Road Safety Awareness Programs reaching out to over 47430 Road Users.
- Started Road Safety Clubs in 10 Govt. Schools and enrolled about 3,500 students.
- Organized innovative Road Safety Programs like Poster exhibitions, motorbike audio, mobile van, rangolli competition with road safety messages and road Safety related drawing competitions in Govt. schools etc.





### Shamshabad: Community Development, Empowerment

- Conducted training program for under-privileged women on making various Jute products.
- Conducted training to women on uniform making.
- Women were trained on making products related to Millet Ready to Eat snacks.



### Pochanpalli Expressway Region: Healthcare

- Organized 24 Medical and Eye camps benefitting about 4150 drivers, laborers and villagers along the highway stretch.
- Organized 20 health awareness programs for 4800 villagers, road users and school students on different health aspects.
- Facilitated donation of 60 units of blood on the occasion of World Blood Donor Day and other occasions.
- Celebrated World Breastfeeding Week, National Safe Motherhood Day, Poshan Abhiyann and National Nutrition Week benefitting about 300 pregnant and lactating women.



## Hyderabad Vijayawada Expressway: Healthcare activities

- Conducted Eye Screening Camps for 442 lorry drivers and villagers and distributed 286 spectacles to the needy.
- Conducted 13 health camps benefiting 962 patients. Organized 05 health awareness programs and reached out to about 350 beneficiaries.
- Conducted Anemia Prevention Program (Project RANI) at Veliminedu ZP High School. Tested HB Levels of 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> class students and supported the anemic students with iron supplements.
- Conducted Active Bleeding Control Training Program to Auto drivers, Street vendors, Police department, Highway patrolling team and Highway ambulance team at Toll Plaza.



## Chennai ORR: Healthcare activities

- General and dental health check-up camps were organized benefitting 1250 students and 5461 community people.
- Free eye camps were conducted for truck drivers and cleaners, 225 spectacles were distributed to the needy
- Celebrated World Breastfeeding Week and National Nutrition Week in Anganwadi center and project villages
- Organized first aid training in 6 colleges, 3 companies four Govt. high schools benefitting 1674 various stakeholders.
- Conducted 84 health awareness programs on hand washing, malaria, dengue, chikungunya, HIV/AIDS and TB reaching out to 8242 community stakeholders.
- Supported about 250 cyclone affected families with relief material
